Rules and Regulations

- 1. To dress our children in an Islamic way is very important. All children must dress appropriately, for boys A **White** Kurta/Thawb/Shalwar Kameez/Jubba etc., Trousers (that stay above the ankles at all times) and a Hat. Clothing should not contain pictures or large writings.
- 2. Uneven haircuts are not allowed in Islam. Therefore short back and sides or any other styles are not allowed. Any child with un-Islamic haircut will not be allowed in the Madrasah.
- 3. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) are obliged to respect the timings. Punctual attendance of the times given is necessary from Monday to Friday. Students are expected to arrive on time for classes and any late arrivals or absentees will not be tolerated.
- 4. All absences must be explained by a note signed by the parent/guardian upon return.
- 5. In the case of any event whereby the student needs to take a number of days off, permission should be sought from the Head Teacher.
- 6. A re-registration fee will apply for any child who leaves the madrasah and wishes to re-join subject to availability.
- 7. Parents/guardians shall be expected to ensure that the child prepares for his/her lessons at home.
- 8. Any queries or complaints should be made only to the Head teacher not directly to a teacher. There must be no interruptions made by any parent or representative whilst teaching is in progress.
- 9. Any behavioural problems from a student will not be tolerated and appropriate action will be taken. The Madrasah has a strict 4 stage behaviour policy. If the student misbehaves then these steps will be taken in sequence, though some behaviour may result in immediate expulsion.
- Stage 1: A verbal warning
- Stage 2: The Head Teacher will discuss the matter with the student and Detention given.
- Stage 3: Letter will be sent home and The Parents/Guardians of the child will be called in to have a meeting with the Head Teacher and class Teacher and the student may be suspended.
- Stage 4: The student will be excluded if deemed appropriate
- 10. The Madrasah has a detention policy which applies to all children, irrespective of age. Any Teacher or the Head Teacher can give detention to any child if they consider it necessary and has the right to keep the child back after class hours up to 15 minutes without prior notice. If a child is given detention for more than 15 minutes, then a letter will be sent home with the child, to notify the parent/guardian in advance. Failure to attend the detention will lead to the child being suspended.
- 11. Parents/Guardians should notify the Head teacher prior to admission of any health problems that their child has. Also keep the Madrasah informed of the child's health.
- 12. Parents/Guardians will not interfere with regards to the running and arrangements of the Madrasah.

- 13. Children are not allowed to attend the Madrasah with mobile phones; hand held game consoles, iPods, iPads, mp3s, Penknives, sweets, chewing gum etc. Any child found to be in possession of any of these items will have them confiscated immediately and may not be returned to the child. 14. All **females** coming to drop and /or collect the child *must* cover their heads (in accordance with Islamic ethics) 15. Any deliberate damage to the property of the masjid will have to be reimbursed by the parents/guardians. 16. Safety of the children outside the lesson hours in masjid premises is the responsibility of the
- parents/guardians.
- 17. Students are not allowed to take part in any activity during the class hours. E.g. clubs, trips, family outings etc.
- 18. All the above Rules and Regulations and any further rules decided by the Head teacher or committee will have to be followed.
